6. Do not use any other tools other than those recommended to build this product.
7. Please do not use substitute parts. Use only additional or replacement parts supplied by Kettler.

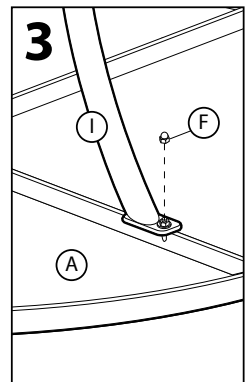
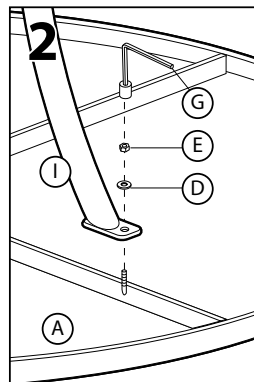
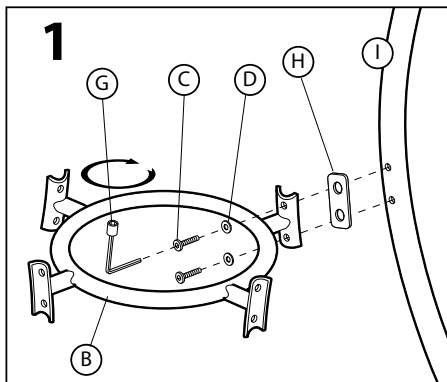
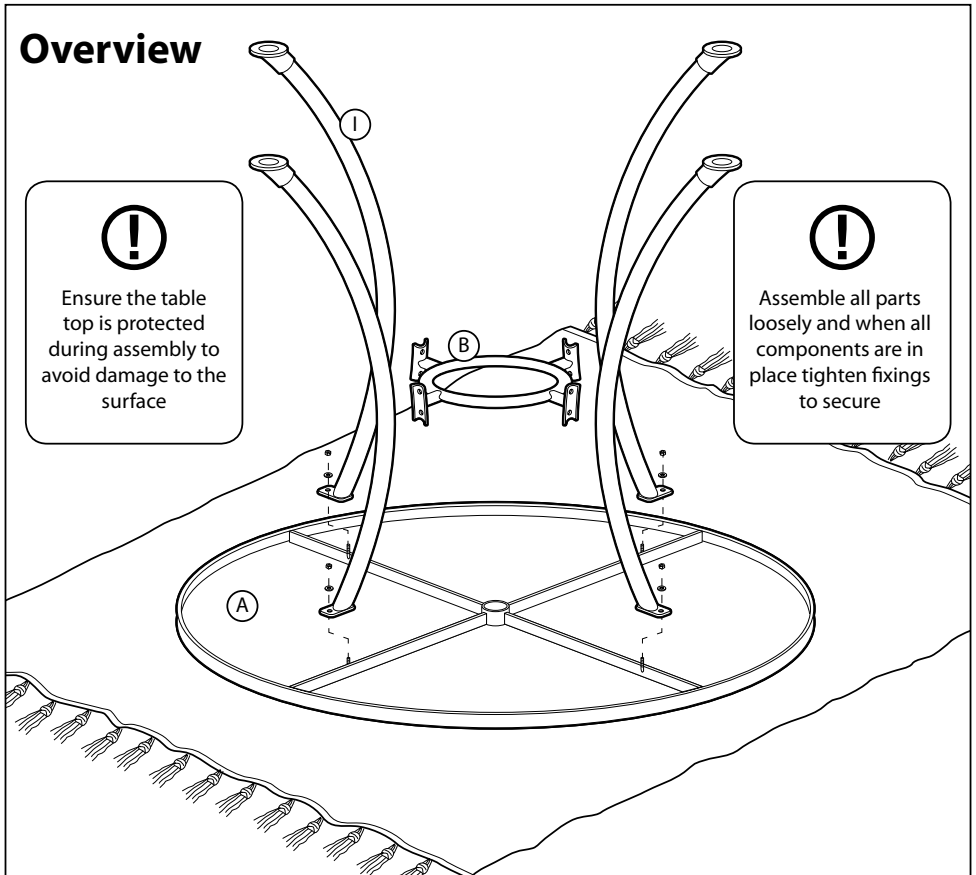
Overview



Ensure the table top is protected during assembly to avoid damage to the surface



Assemble all parts loosely and when all components are in place tighten fixings to secure
